



Key dates


- 30th June 2023 NECP draft submission deadline (CZ submitted in October 2023)
 - Platform for Energy and Climate Strategies established in spring 2023
- 30th June 2024 final NECP submission deadline (in preparation)
- 30th June 2025 Social Climate Plan submission deadline (in preparation)
 - working groups established early 2024
- Social Climate Fund starting in 2026

EMPLOYMENT WAM (NKEP3) compared to WEM, Czech Republic 2020-2050



Legal obligations for public participation during NECP update

- Provisions must be introduced to **guarantee public participation**
- There must be arrangements for the public to participate within a **transparent and fair framework**, with **rules and procedures applied in a clear and consistent** fashion
- Certain information should be provided to the public
- Reasonable time frames must be set

- Public participation **must take place early, when all options are open** and effective participation can take place
- Due account is to be taken of the outcome of the public participation
- Identification of the public to participate: who may participate?

10 steps for public participation

- 1. Identification of the public concerned
- 2. Publication of a public notice explaining the NECP updating process
- 3. Publication of a draft NECP update as a basis
- 4. Publication of any other information, facts and analyses relating to the preliminary strategies, policies and measures laid out in the draft NECP
- Carrying out public participation Ensure that the public consultation is early, fair, effective, transparent, and informed

6. Engaging in Multilevel Climate and Energy Dialogues7. Adjust the draft update NECP to reflect the outcome of the public participation (consultations, stakeholder dialogues)

8. Submission and publication of a draft NECP to the EU Commission

- 9. Incorporating recommendations from EU
- Commission's assessment
- 10. Submission and publication of the final updated NECP


Obstacles for effective public participation

- lack of capacities and expertise
- lack of funding
- lack of political will and understanding of benefits of public participation

Social Climate Fund

50 bn CZK available (~2 bn EUR)

56 % for buildings and transport - 28 bn 37,5 % for direct compensation - 18,8 bn 2,5 % technical assistance 4 % additional technical assistance



Social Climate Plan preparation

- 3 working groups including a wide variety of experts
 - buildings
 - \circ transport
 - direct compensation
- interministerial working group on energy poverty
- Green Savings Light programme as a good practice up to 100 % of funding upfront

Challenges of SCF

- Limited amount of funds need for a clear target group
- Lack of relevant and sufficient data for good targeting
 - maximizing both climate and social benefit
- Unclear relationship between energy and transport poverty
- Reaching the most vulnerable target groups (see Green Savings Light)
- Addressing energy poverty in rental housing
